National Match M1 Auction.....Terms and Conditions.....

1. All bidders must be members of SDSSA or the GCA. SDSSA Memberships are \$10/yr. Application for membership available at **www.sdshootingsports.org**. Place copy of your current 2010 membership card or the membership application and payment inside the bidding envelope mentioned in item# 4 when placing your bid.
2. Bidding starts at \$2000.00 minimum and is to be done on SDSSA Bid Sheet available at **www.sdshootingsports.org**
3. Bid sheets should be placed in a small sealed envelope marked with the words **NM M1 Garand Bid** and the name of the bidder. This small envelope should be placed in a #10 envelope and sent to SDSSA at PO Box 3, Dell Rapids, SD. Bids need to be delivered to PO Box 3 on or before April 30th, 2010. Include a copy of your 2010 membership card or your membership application and \$10 payment in the bid envelope.
4. Bids will be opened at the 2010 Annual Meeting of SD Shooting Sports in May, 2010.
5. Highest bidder will be notified and has 7 days to deliver a Certified Bank Draft, US Postal Money Order or cash to SDSSA. If the highest bidder is unable to take delivery of the auctioned firearm, then the next highest bidder will be notified and that bidder will then have 7 days to deliver described funds to SDSSA.
6. The successful bidder will need to pass the NICS check done by an FFL Dealer. We can also arrange to have an FFL Dealer ship the firearm to a local FFL of his/her choosing to do the transfer. All transfer costs and shipping expenses will be paid by the successful bidder.
7. In case of a TIE for high bid, the earliest bid submitted (PM) will prevail. All other bid discrepancies will be decided by the Executive Board of SD Shooting Sports.
8. Incomplete bids, failure to have current membership certification or late delivery to PO box will disqualify submitted bid.
