

View of this beautiful NM M1 Garand from Springfield Arms. As you can see this rifle is in impeccable condition and is a national match tuned firearm straight from US Army Armorer's. SD Shooting Sports has had this M1 in it's possession since it was built in the early 1960's and sent to us by the DCM. Then SDSSA purchased the rifle from the DCM in 1993. This is the **One Owner Gun** you dream about buying!



This highly accurate rifle for the serious competitor or shooter was assembled from selected parts that met strict tolerances. National Match Garands were fitted with national match front sight and complete National Match rear sights capable of 1/2 minute windage and elevation adjustments. Trigger pulls adjusted to NM specs and all creep and excess travel removed for crisp trigger pull. Front handguard is unitized to lower band and the gas cylinder is modified to all NM specs. The action is glass bedded to the stock. Once the Army Marksmanship Unit completed assembly, each rifle was then fully tested and targeted for reliability, safety, accuracy, and function. The National Match M1 Garand are the Cadillac's of the M1 Garand Rifles.



This photo gives you the view of the heel of the receiver and the stampings. These stampings also appear on the paperwork from the US Army to verify that this rifle was sent to South Dakota Shooting Sports.
