DATE: Sept. 11, 2010

RANGE LOCATION

From Timber Lake go 3 miles north and east on highway 20, 1 mile west on the gravel road, 3 miles north, 2 miles west and ½ mile north. The range is located 200 yards on the right. Turns will be marked from the highway to the range.

REGISTRATION

Registration begins at 9:30 AM MDT/10:30 CDT and closes at 1:00 PM MDT/ 2:00 PM CDT the day of the match. Shooting will begin at 10:00 AM MDT/11:00 AM CDT.

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee for each championship is \$10.50, including \$7.00 for registration fees. If you do not have an NRA rifle classification book you will be required to buy a book from the statistical officer for \$2.00.

COMPETITION

Open to all shooters with current membership in the NRA and SDSSA or of the state association of their residency. Nonmembers will be given the opportunity to apply for NRA and SDSSA memberships at registration time.

RULES

All current NRA rules apply.

CLASSIFICATION

NRA silhouette classification will be used. All unclassified shooters will compete in the highest available class or unclassified class.

COURSE OF FIRE

Championships will consist of 2-40 shot matches with 10 shots fired at each animal for each match. The Silhouette Rifle Championship will be fired first with the Hunting Rifle Championship fired immediately after its completion and decision of any ties.

AWARDS

SD Championship plaques, provided by the SDSSA, will be awarded to the highest scoring SD resident in each championship. If a nonresident fires the highest score, the sponsor will provide a suitable award.

A minimum of 70% of the entry fees will be awarded to other winners, according to the following guidelines. Competitors have the option of a cash award or trophies. Trophies or cash awards will be provided for second overall, first in each class with at least three entries, second in each class with five or more entries. The sponsor reserves the right to combine classes for awards purposes where appropriate. Master and AAA shooters will shoot for high overall only. If there are two or more juniors entered, a junior category will be provided. The high score senior in either championship will receive the SD Senior Championship award provided by the sponsors if two or more seniors are entered.

DISTANCE AWARDS

These will be provided at each range. AAA class shooters will be eligible for 10-in-a-row pins only but may purchase any 5-in-a-row pins earned.

TIES

All ties will be determined by shoot-offs fired at the end of each championship.

LIABILITY AND ENDEMNITY

Due to high cost of insurance, all participants will be required to sign a waiver of LIABILITY AND ENDEMNITY AGREEMENT. All minor participants must have a parent or guardian sign for them.
